The Remakery is a hub for craft based practitioners, hobbyists and community organisers. Through our passion for varied hands-on skills, we contribute to the growing body of evidence that a thriving future will be built from the ground up.

Future Makers is a new programme of workshops and events focussing on the power of hand-making to change the future. Our vision is to support Lambeth Residents to Remake Lambeth as a resilient, prosperous network of interdependent Eco-Makers.



We are looking for 4 inspiring practitioners, who already have a background in developing craft techniques that respond to the climate crisis, to join our practitioner network.

We have grant funding to support selected practitioners to;

Undertake a research and development project into a technique or product that can deliver clear environmental benefits in their field.

Create content for Youtube and Instagram that documents this innovation.

Create and deliver two workshops that share this innovation with our wider community.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We believe in the power of ‘everyday craft’; we are looking for projects that can become part of everyday lives in Lambeth.

You could explore a technique that’s new to you, but takes your practice to the next level.

- Extracting essential oils from locally grown plants,
- Exploring a particular natural dye technique,
- Developing an upcycled garment that keeps textiles waste out of landfill,
- Working with wood waste to replace a plastic product.

Don’t worry that your idea is too simple, or if it’s been done before. We want to develop local knowledge that is relevant to our community and demonstrates achievable ways to change how we live in Lambeth

If you are selected The Remakery will;

Commission your R and D project (£1200). Purchase equipment that you will need and make space available for you to complete your project. (£200+). Support you with a trained social media creator to document your process for YouTube and Instagram (£400). Support you to create 2 workshops (paid at £150 per workshop), sharing your knowledge with The Remakery Community. Add your workshops to The Remakery programme, including creating Eventbrites, marketing materials and featuring you on our website.

After you complete your project, you have the option to utilise Remakery communal space going forward, as well as be part of our Practitioner Network and deliver paid workshops at events in the future.

How will we choose?

All applicants must live or work in Lambeth.

We're looking for practitioners who are dedicated to building a practice that supports community led 'Regenerative Culture', i.e. a culture that can restore biodiversity loss, stop producing pollution or waste, make things for itself without carbon emissions and care for the most vulnerable including vulnerable species.

We're looking for outcomes that are inspiring and accessible to local residents. We want to involve our community in pushing innovations forward, so the more your idea feels relevant to local residents, the better.
