The Chance to pitch for up to £1000 of seed funding, at our 'Community Fund Launch'.

Ongoing 1-1 support with tricky stuff like registering with HMRC submitting your paperwork.

Access to our network of community organisers and green initiative supporters to get your idea in front of the right people.

The Remakery is a hub for eco craft based practitioners, hobbyists and community organisers. Through our passion for varied hands-on skills, we contribute to the growing body of evidence that a thriving future will be built from the ground up.

There is plenty of evidence that the best ideas for transforming communities come from within the communities themselves. But not everyone has equal access to the resources and expertise that make businesses work.

The Remakery has put together a package of support for local eco-entrepreneurs to help them explore exciting transformative business ideas, and get them off the ground.

What is an Incubator?

An Incubator is a series of workshops and activities that take someone starting an enterprise through the steps from a genius idea to launching a product or service.

Incubators guide entrepreneurs through all the steps of how to make a project work. Our

Incubator is specifically aimed at 'Mission Led' projects, and people from diverse backgrounds.

So we have an extra focus on telling your story, looking after your mental health, and how to get going without going into debt.

Support for Successful Applicants

We have designed this programme with expert business knowledge - we believe this is the best way The Remakery can support you to get your project up and running.

Everyone who completes the incubator (attends all 8 sessions, creates a Business Canvas and a Cash flow) will get a New Enterprise Support Package including:

- **A year's membership at The Remakery with access to hotdesking and a communal workshop space 8 hours a week**
- **A mentoring session every three months**
- **A feature spot on The Remakery website and social media**
- **A chance to pitch for Startup Seed Funding (for up to £1000) at our Community Pitch event in association with Brixton Project and Brixton Pound**

We are also offering a £240 bursary for up to 10 applicants who are under 25 or in difficult financial circumstances that they can put towards further development of their idea. (to receive this bursary, you must attend all sessions, complete a Business Canvas & Cash flow, and pitch your business idea at our pitch event).

Future Makers Community Fund

The Remakery are teaming up with Brixton Project and Brixton Pound to start a new Community Fund for Brixton.

The Future Makers Community Fund aims to support micro enterprises and projects that have the potential to transform our area into a regenerative culture.

To launch the fund we will be holding our first Pitch Event on the 11th March
With SeedFunding of up to £1000 available for great new enterprises.

Participants from the Future Makers Incubator will be invited to pitch to a room of local changemakers and residents who will decide how best to allocate our grant pot so that great ideas can get started.

Not only is this a great chance to get your first bit of funding, it's also a chance to network with potential supporters who are working in the same space as you and will really get your mission.
