What does it mean to be a Partner Practitioner?

By becoming a Partner Practitioner for one of our rooms, you are part of the small team (4 people per room) who Activate the room through;



Your own Ecological Research and Development;

Using the specialist space and equipment to develop the ecological benefits, circularity, waste reduction or functionality of your practise



Knowledge Sharing with the Community;

Offering workshops and inductions to make your practice accessible to our Remakery community.



Hosting Activation Days;

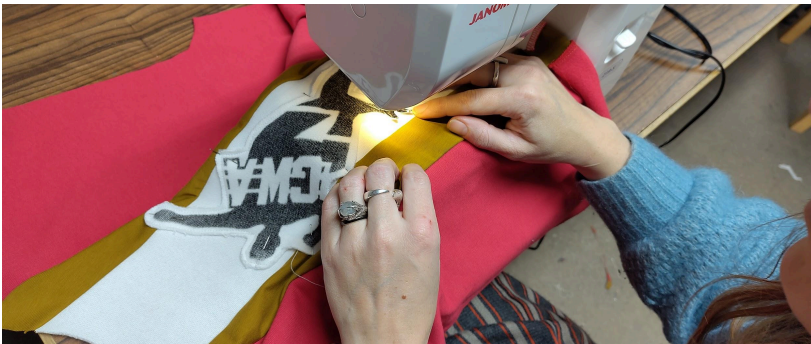
Being part of a rota to offer safe access to the communal rooms one day a month.

ECOLOGICAL RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

The Communal Rooms have been designed and fitted out in partnership with Ecological Practitioners, so that they are suitable for Green Transition Research and Development.

As a Partner Practitioner you would have access to the room 3 days a week (Monday to Wednesday) to complete your own work.

This could be Research and Development on a new technique, a short production run for commercial purposes, or trialling a new workshop or course idea.



We will support you with expertise in sourcing and supply chains as well as business support, to make your practice the best it can be for you, the community and the environment.

You will receive designated storage space, and you will be invited to pitch for new equipment to develop your ideas.

*Please note that we have noise restrictions in our building; power tools or machinery can only be used 8-6 Monday to Friday and 9-1 on Saturdays

KNOWLEDGE SHARING WITH THE COMMUNITY

A core aim of the Remakery is to help people experience the Green Economy, and a Green Transition, through Ecological DIY and Crafts.

As a Partner Practitioner you will be required to offer an induction onto the machinery/tools in your space, once every 4 months (in the first 6 months, to be renegotiated every 6 months). Inductions will be paid at £30 for an hour session.

We will work with our Partner Practitioners to develop valuable courses as an additional revenue stream for their practice. These may be funded by the Remakery (£150 for 3 hours) or funded through ticket sales.



Partner Practitioners will be required to contribute to our reporting. Every month you will need to submit numbers that we can send to Lambeth to show how the Remakery is nurturing the Green Transition. This reporting should take no longer than 1 hour a month.

HOSTING ACTIVATION DAYS

In exchange for free access to the rooms, Partner Practitioners are required to take on a technician role once every 4 weeks.

This allows us to safely open the space to the Community on Activation Days.

Activation Days are Fridays 10am - 6pm (including a 1 hour break for lunch)



During an Activation Day you will be required to:

- Open up the Room and check it is safe and tidy.
- Setup any equipment that has been booked for the day.
- Monitor how the room is being used and check that community users are acting safely and within the Communal Room Guidelines.
- Check that each Community user has tidied away after themselves, and lock the room at the end of the Session

Or, if there are no bookings on that Friday;

Create a piece of Instagram or YouTube content that showcases your work and the communal room, and submit it to The Remakery team for posting.

Activation Days will be assigned to Practitioners at random, it is the responsibility of the practitioner to arrange a swap if needed.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Access to the Communal Room (Bench Workshop and Woodworking, Lab Space, or Textiles Room) is dependent on the Partner Practitioner;

- Showing competency in safe use of specialist equipment.
- Reporting any accidents or equipment in need of service or repair within 24 hours of the incident/discovery.
- Keeping spaces clear of materials, projects, tools or waste whilst they are not in use.
- Having relevant insurance to cover your private services and product sales.
- Hosting Activation Days with care and attention.
- Arranging an alternative technician if you cannot host your allocated Activation Day
- Hosting inductions competently.
- Submitting relevant reporting and social media content by the last day of each month.

Should a Partner Practitioner fail to meet any of the above terms, they will no longer have access to the communal space. Once a Partner Practitioner agreement has been terminated, the Partner Practitioner will have 1 week to clear any of their items out of rooms and storage.

The Partner Practitioner Offer is reviewed and negotiated every 6 months between- The Remakery, Partner Practitioners and Community Users
